P R E F A C E

Under the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 2021 (RBDA 2021)¹, the Registry of Births and Deaths has been charged with the responsibility of registering all live births, stillbirths and deaths in Singapore.

The Report on Registration of Births and Deaths, 2022 is the 35th publication in the annual series by the Registry. The Report aims to provide an overview of the annual changes in the population, births, deaths and other vital statistics². The statistical tables and charts on vital statistics will be of interest to academics, demographers and medical professionals. Specimen certificates of and procedures for the registration of births, stillbirths and deaths have been included in the annexure.

The Registry of Births and Deaths gratefully acknowledges the assistance and contribution of the Ministry of Health, the Department of Statistics, the Singapore Police Force and all other agencies in the publication of this Report.

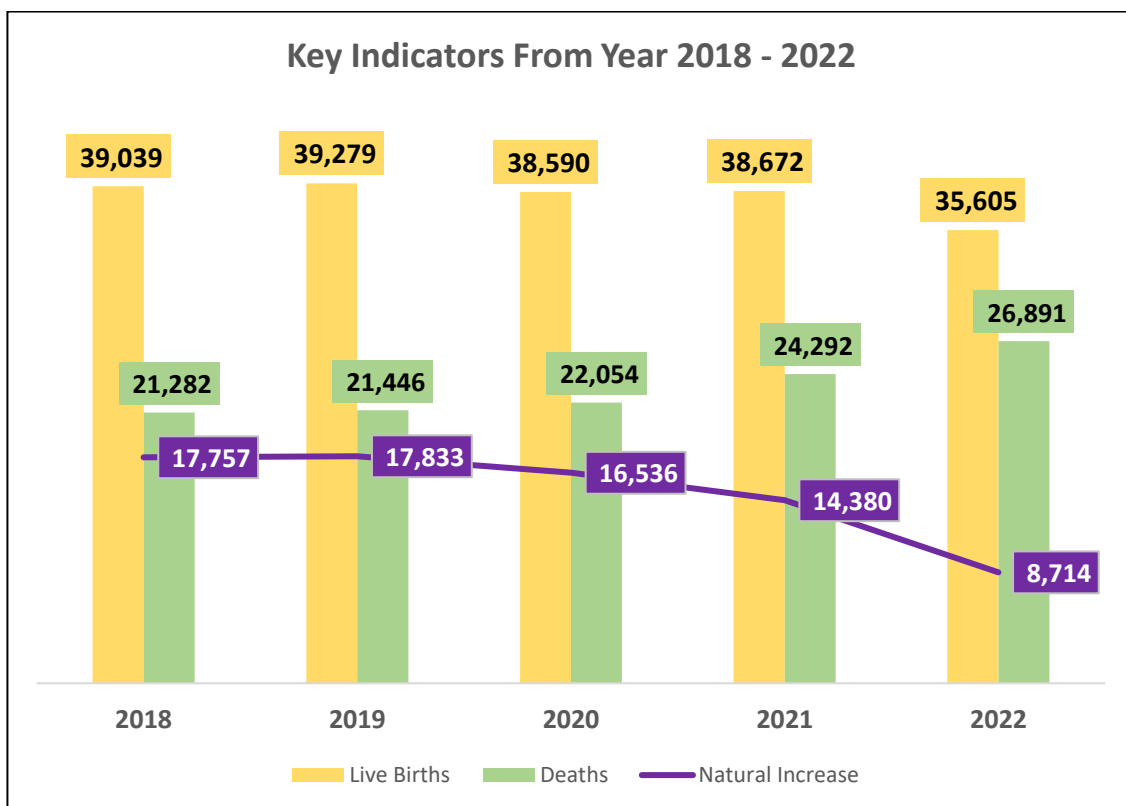

In 2022, there were 35,605 occurred live births, 26,891 registered deaths, and 110 registered stillbirths. Compared to 2021, live births decreased by 7.9%, while registered deaths increased by 10.7%.

Note 1: Infant mortality refers to death of persons under one year of age. Crude infant mortality rate refers to the number of infant deaths per thousand live births. From 1980 onwards, this rate is based on resident live births only.

Note 2: Neonatal mortality refers to death of persons under 28 days of age. Crude neonatal mortality rate refers to the number of neonatal deaths per thousand live births. From 1990 onwards, this rate is based on resident live births only.

General

The Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) administers the Registration of Births and Deaths Act 2021 (RBDA 2021). On 29 May 2022, the RBDA 1937 was repealed and the RBDA 2021 was enacted. Under this Act, all live births, deaths, and stillbirths occurring within Singapore and its territorial waters are required to be reported within the stipulated period. Prior to enactment of the RBDA 2021, the Registry also re-registers births under the Adoption of Children Act.

2 In 2022, there were 35,605 occurred live births, 26,891 registered deaths and 134 registered stillbirths. In this report, date of occurrence is adopted for the compilation of births statistics while date of registration is adopted for deaths statistics.

Late Registrations

3 Live births registered after 42 days from occurrence are classified as late registrations. In 2022, there were 25 late registrations of live births. Of these, 0 cases were registered after a lapse of 12 months from the date of birth.

4 Deaths registered after three days from occurrence are treated as late registrations³. In 2022, there were 20 late registrations of deaths. Of these, 11 cases were registered after seven days from the date of death.

Re-registration of Adopted Children

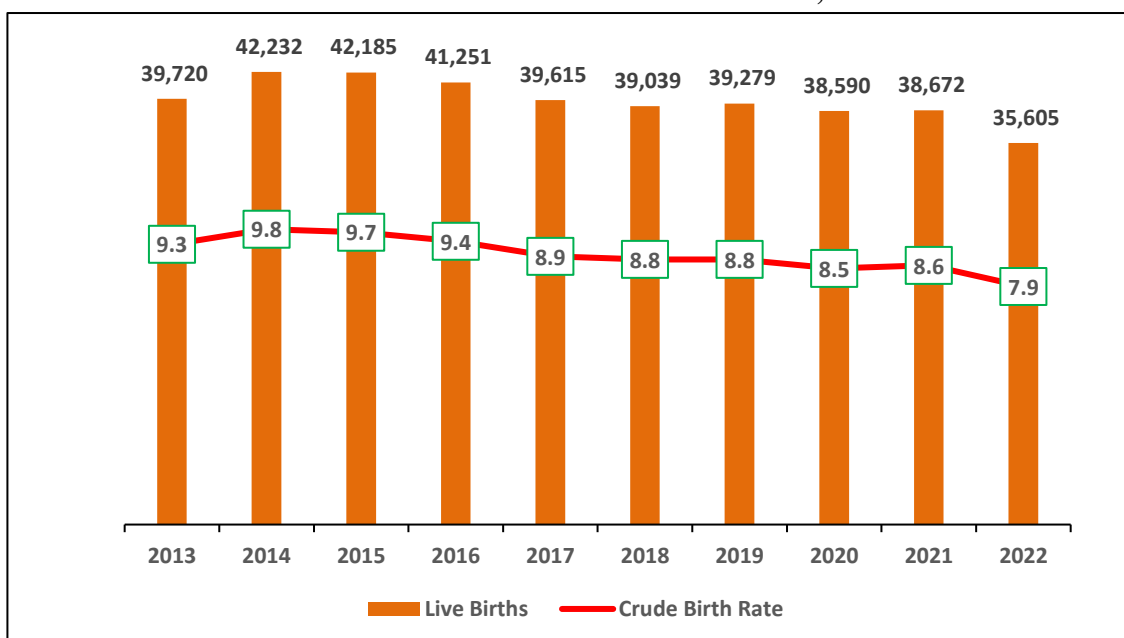
5 Under the Adoption of Children Act, the birth of a child shall be registered under the RBDA upon an Adoption Order issued by the Court. If the child's birth had previously been registered under the RBDA, the name of the child, as well as the names and other particulars of the adoptive parents, as recorded in the Adoption Order, are entered in the birth register in place of the natural or last adoptive parents of the child. In 2022, 271 children were adopted and registered/re-registered under the RBDA.

Live Births

6 In 2022, there were 35,605 live births, reflecting a 7.9% decline from the previous year's count of 38,672. The crude birth rate, calculated at 7.9 per 1,000 Singapore residents, was lower than the rate observed in 2021 (Chart 1).

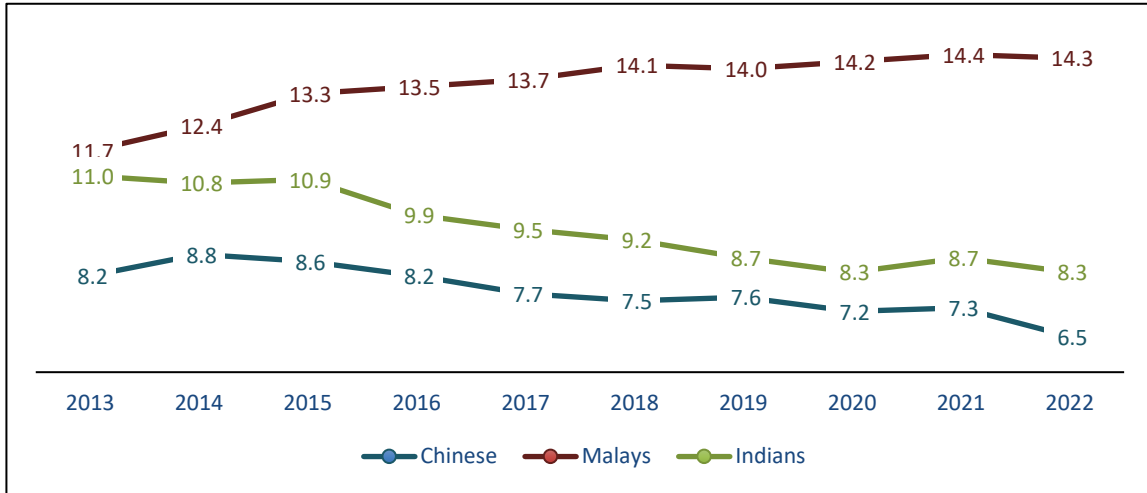

7 Out of the total newborns in 2022, Chinese newborns accounted for 56.4% (20,073), Malays for 22.4% (7,958), Indians for 11.4% (4,071), and individuals of other races for 9.8% (3,503). In 2022, Malays had the highest birth rate, with 14.3 per 1,000 residents, followed by Indians with 8.3 per 1,000 residents. Chinese had the lowest rate at 6.5 per 1,000 residents (Chart 2).

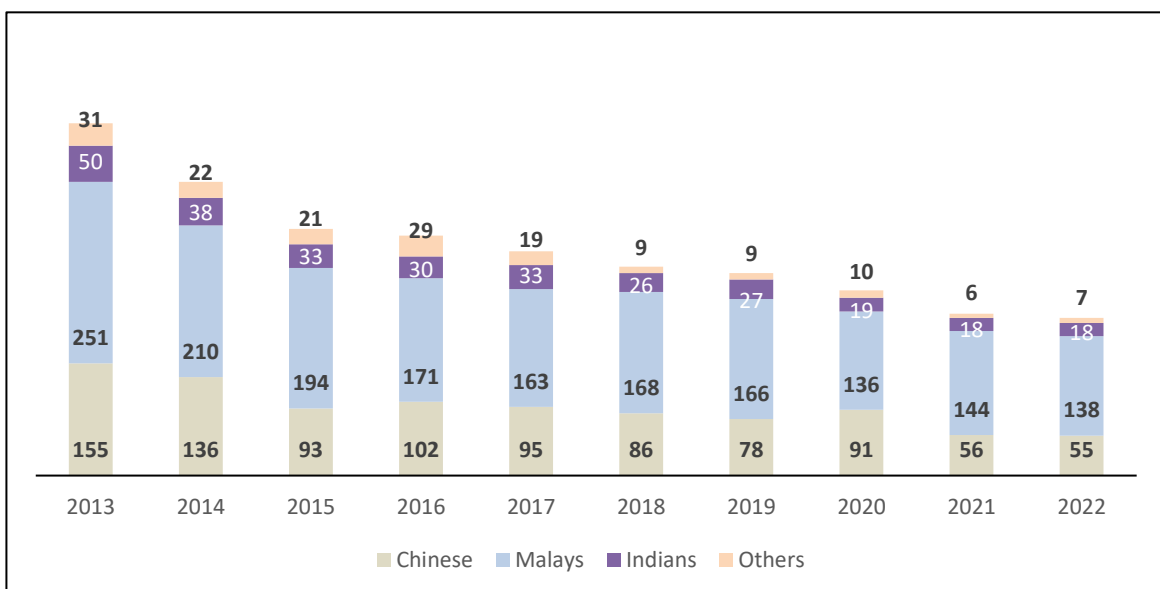

Teenage Births

8 In 2022, the number of live births among teenagers aged 19 and below was 218, showing a slight 2.7% decrease compared to the 224 births recorded in 2021. By proportion, 25.2% of teenage births were born to Chinese, 63.3% to Malays, 8.3% to Indians and 3.2% to other ethnic groups.

TEENAGE BIRTHS BY ETHNIC GROUP, 2013 – 2022



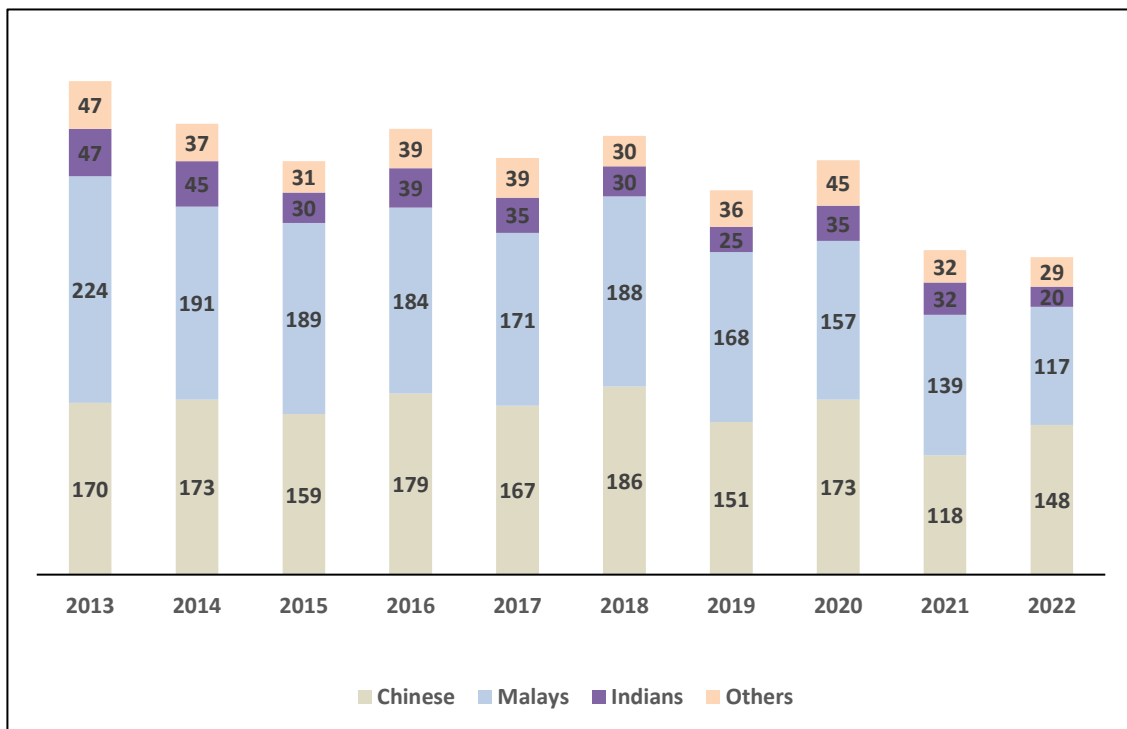
Live Births

Single-Parent Birth Registration (SP Birth)

9 In 2022, a total of 314 live births were registered without the father’s name (Chart 4). Of these 314 SP births, 65 (20.7%) births were born to teenagers aged 19 and below.

10 Chinese made up the largest proportion of SP birth in 2022. 47.1% of SP births were born to Chinese, 37.3% to Malays, 6.4% to Indians and 9.2% to other ethnic groups.

SP BIRTH BY ETHNIC GROUP, 2013 – 2022

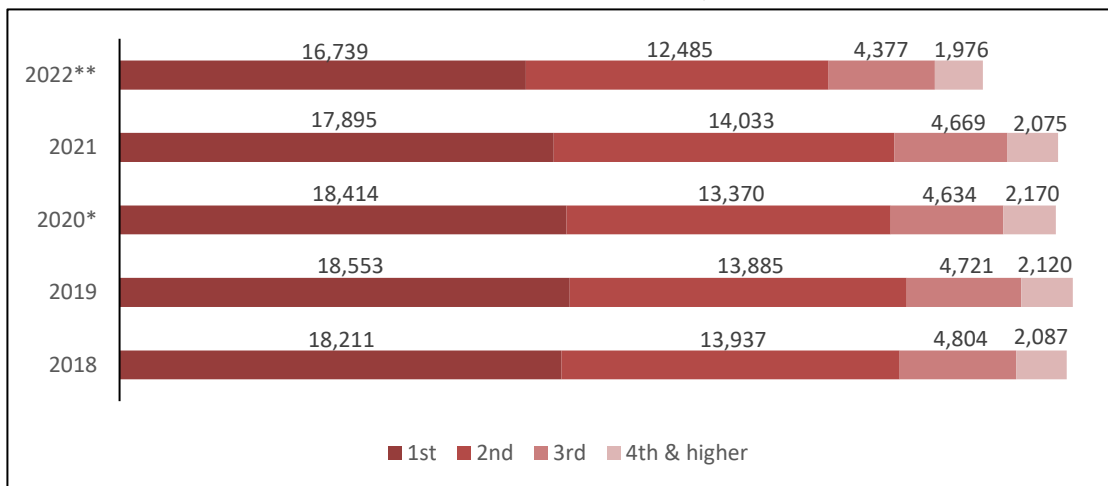


Birth Order

11 In 2022, the distribution of live births was as follows: 47.0% were 1st order births, 35.1% were 2nd order births, 12.3% were 3rd order births, and 5.5% were 4th and higher order births (Chart 5).

LIVE BIRTHS BY BIRTH ORDER, 2018 – 2022**

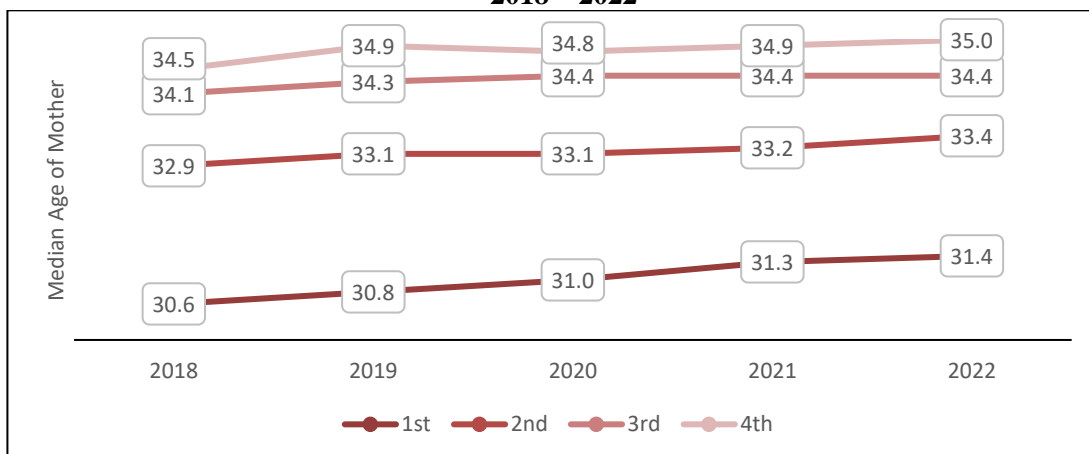

12 An analysis of resident birth order data reveals a clear trend of first-time mothers progressively delaying childbirth to later stages of their lives. The median age of first-time mothers rose from 30.6 years in 2018 to 31.4 years in 2022. The median age of mothers giving birth to their second or subsequent child has shown minimal change over the same period (Chart 6).

Live Births

First-Time Mothers

13 In 2022, the median age of first-time mothers among resident live births was 31.4 years at the time of giving birth. Among specific ethnic groups, Chinese mothers typically have their first child at the age of 32.2 years, Malay mothers at 28.3 years, and Indian mothers at 30.5 years. Mothers from other ethnic groups have a median age of 32.1 years when having their first child.

14 Among these first-time mothers, 64.1% had university degrees and 35.9% had 'A' level / Diploma / ITE or lower qualification.

Live Births

Type of Birth and Period of Gestation

15 In 2022, there were 34,655 single births, 932 twin births, and 18 triplet births.

16 Among single births, the most common gestation period observed was 38 weeks, comprising 34.2% of all single births. Twin births, on the other hand, predominantly occurred at 37 weeks, constituting 30.0% of the total number of twin births. Premature single births, defined as those with a gestation period of 36 weeks or less, amounted to 2,264 cases, making up 6.5% of all single births. Among twin births, a significant proportion of 63.3% consisted of premature deliveries with a gestation period of 36 weeks or less.

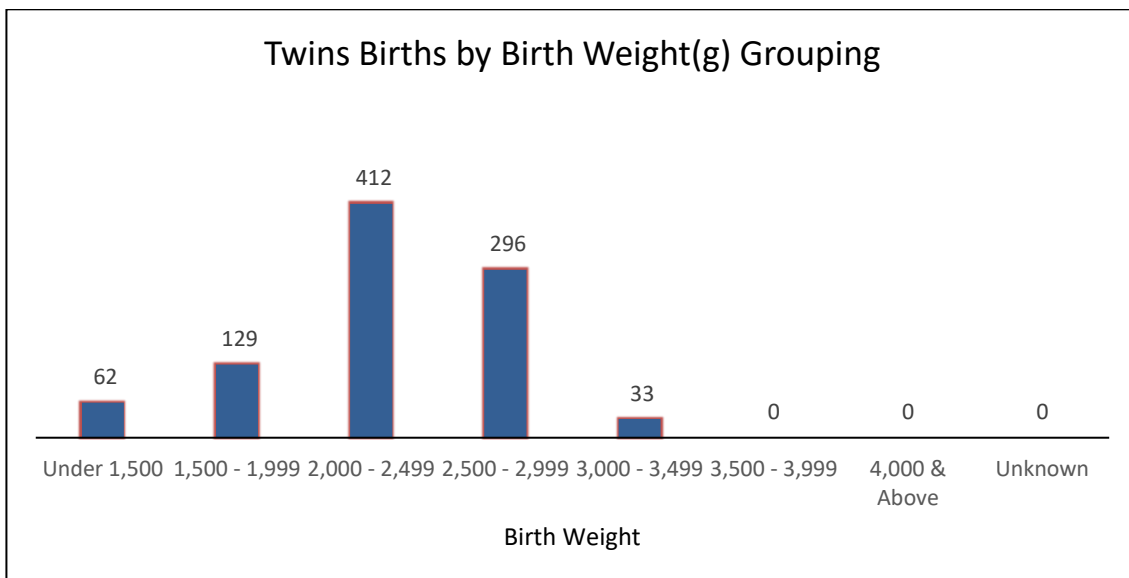
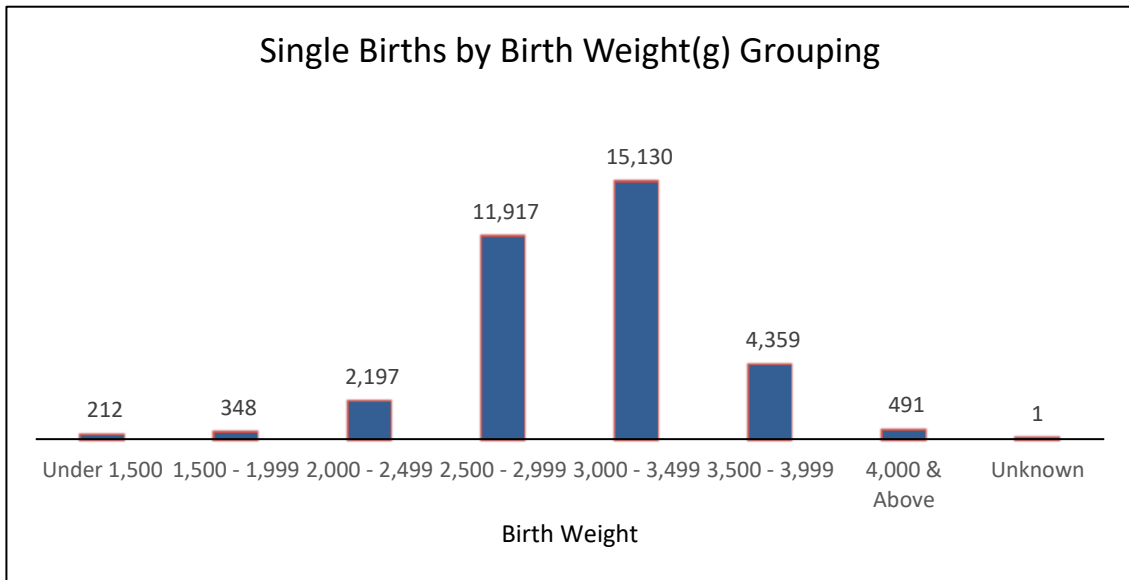

17 Chart 7 reflects a strong tendency that twin births were generally lighter in weight than single births.

BY BIRTH WEIGHT, 2022

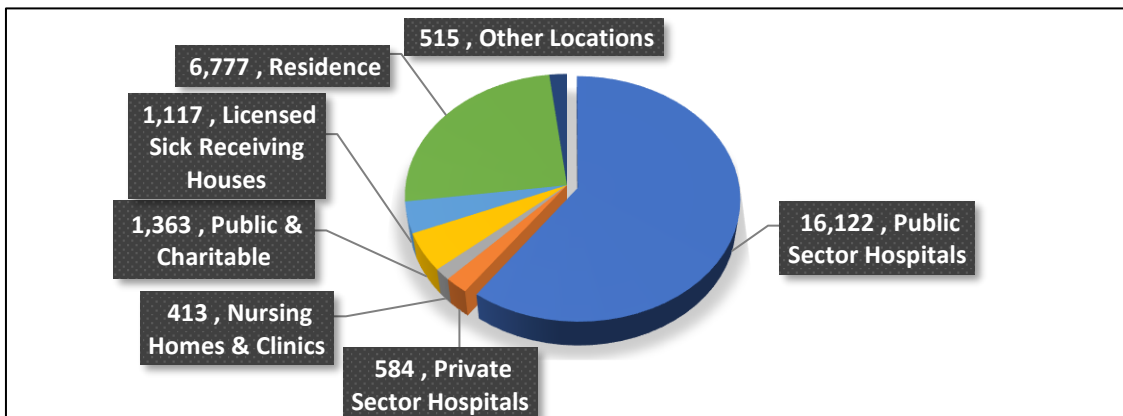


Deaths

18 In 2022, the total number of registered deaths reached 26,891, indicating an increase of 2,599 cases (equivalent to a 10.7% rise) compared to the 24,292 deaths registered in 2021.

19 The combined percentage of deaths that occurred within both public and private hospitals accounted for 62.1% of the total fatalities. Of the total deaths, 25.2% occurred in residences, 6.6% were in nursing homes and charitable institutions, 4.2% were in sick receiving houses and 1.9% at other locations.

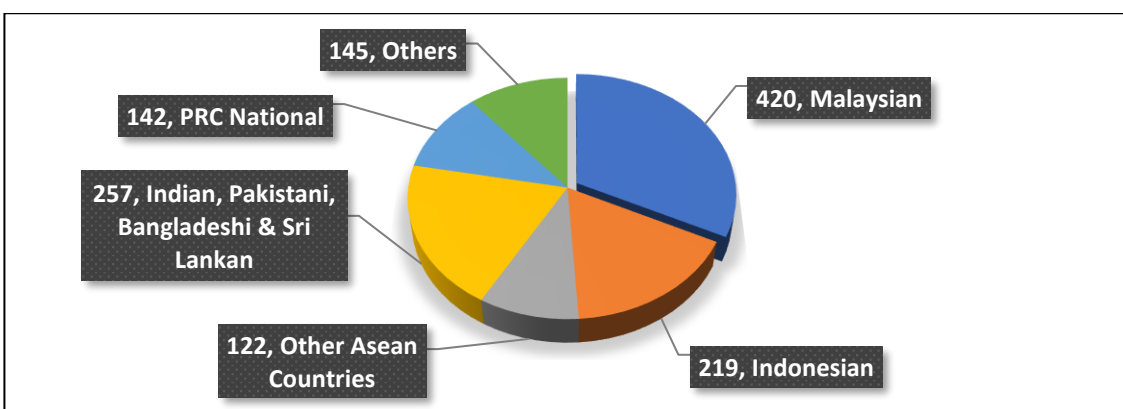

20 4.9% of deaths registered in 2022 were non-Singapore residents (Chart 9). They were mostly Malaysians and Indonesian.

DEATHS BY NON-RESIDENT STATUS, 2022



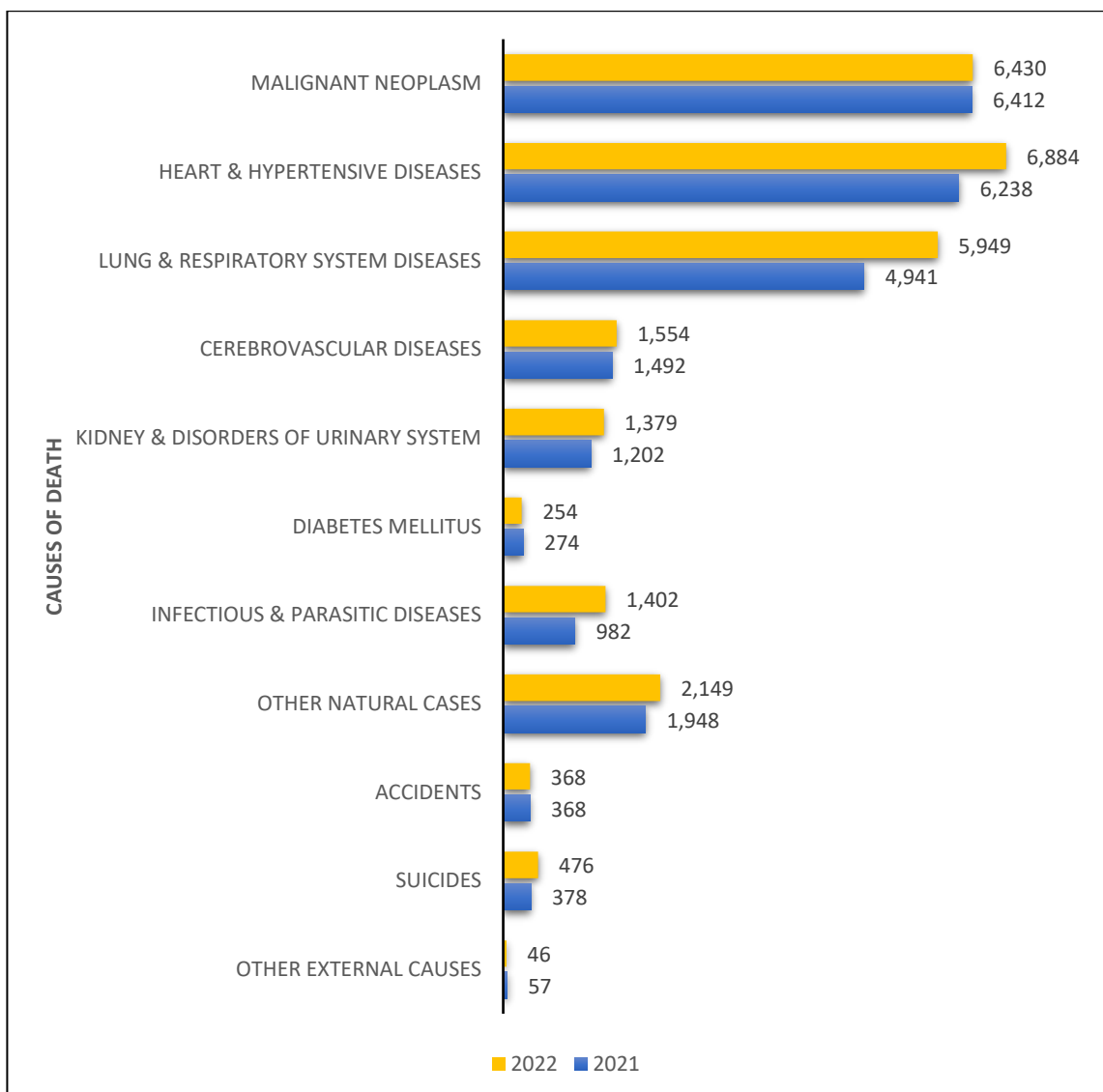
Deaths

Major Causes of Death

21 In 2022, the leading causes of death were malignant neoplasms and heart & hypertensive diseases, collectively accounting for 49.5% of all registered deaths. Additionally, lung & respiratory system diseases and cerebrovascular diseases were prominent factors, responsible for 22.1% and 5.8% of death cases, respectively. Unnatural causes such as accidents, suicides, and other external causes, constituted 3.3% of the total cases. Comparing to the previous year, the proportion of deaths attributed to lung & respiratory system diseases increased by 1.8%, while the proportion of deaths caused by malignant neoplasms decreased by 2.5%.

COMPARATIVE MAJOR CAUSES OF DEATH BETWEEN 2021 AND 2022

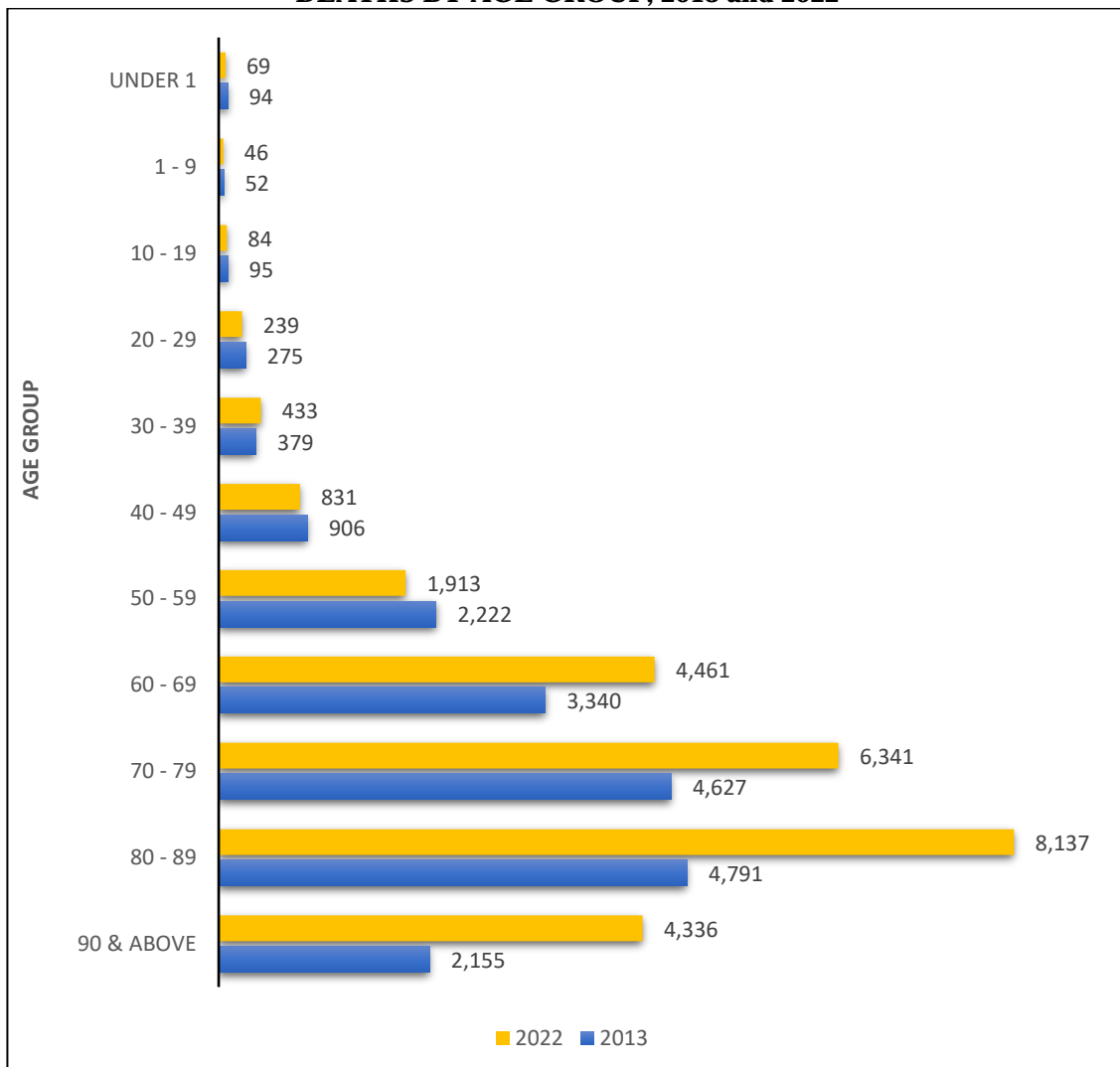


Deaths

Median Age at Death and Sex

22 In 2022, one death case had an unknown age recorded. The majority of deaths, totaling 23,275 persons, were aged 60 years and above, making up 86.6% of the total. Persons between the ages of 50 and 59 accounted for 7.1% of all deaths. Furthermore, there were 69 reported cases of infant deaths (age under one year old), representing 0.3% of the overall death count (Chart 11).

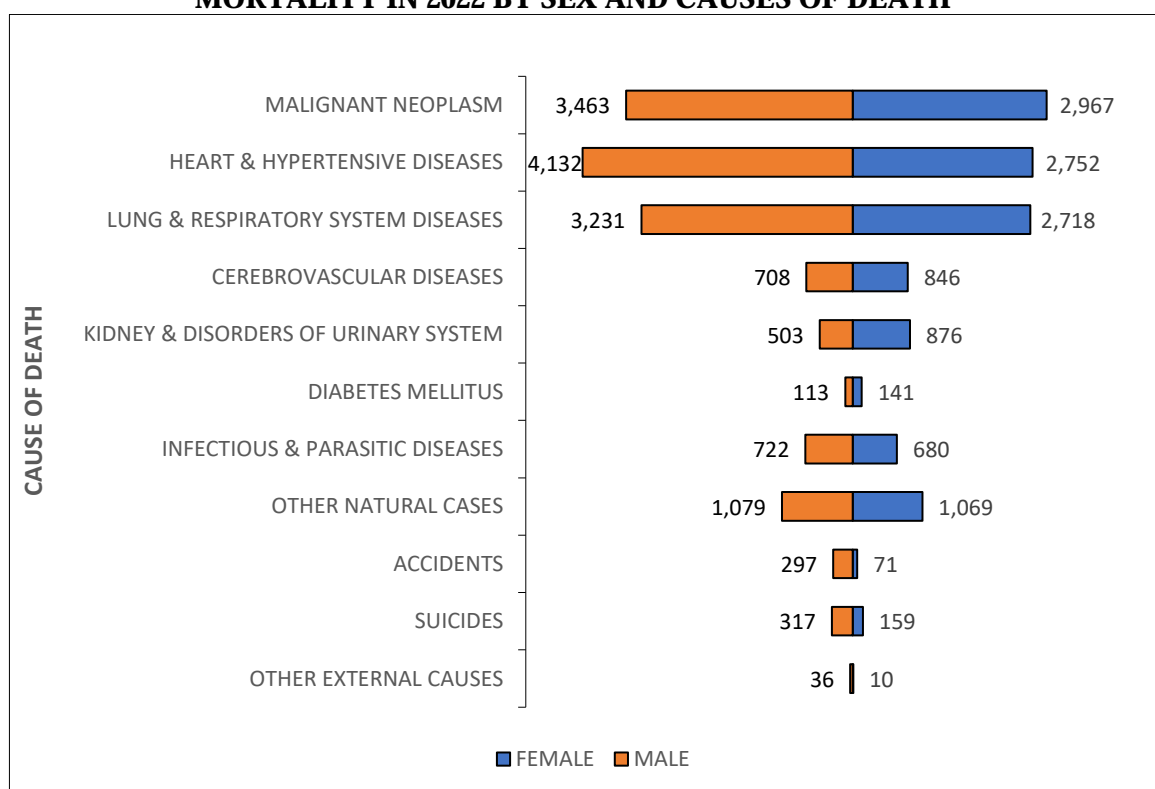

Deaths

23 In terms of mortality, males surpassed females, with a ratio of 1,188 males per 1,000 females. When examining the causes of death across sex, it was observed that males had a higher proportion of deaths attributed to heart and hypertensive diseases, as well as accidents. Conversely, females exhibited a higher proportion of deaths associated with kidney and disorders of urinary system, as well as cerebrovascular diseases (Chart 12).

24 The median age at death (MA in short) was 78.5 years in year 2022. The highest MA of 84.7 years was recorded for those who died of lung & respiratory system diseases, followed by 83.0 years for kidney & disorders of urinary system and 82.7 years for Infectious & Parasitic Diseases.

25 The MA has been gradually increasing over the years. It was 74.9 years in 2013. It increased to 76.6 years and 78.5 years in 2017 and 2022 respectively. Not including other natural causes, the increase in MA was most conspicuous among infectious & parasitic diseases (69.3 year in 2013 to 82.7 year in 2022).

26 Females tend to live longer than their male counterparts. The MA was 75.2 years for males compared to 82.3 years for females, a difference of 7.1 years.

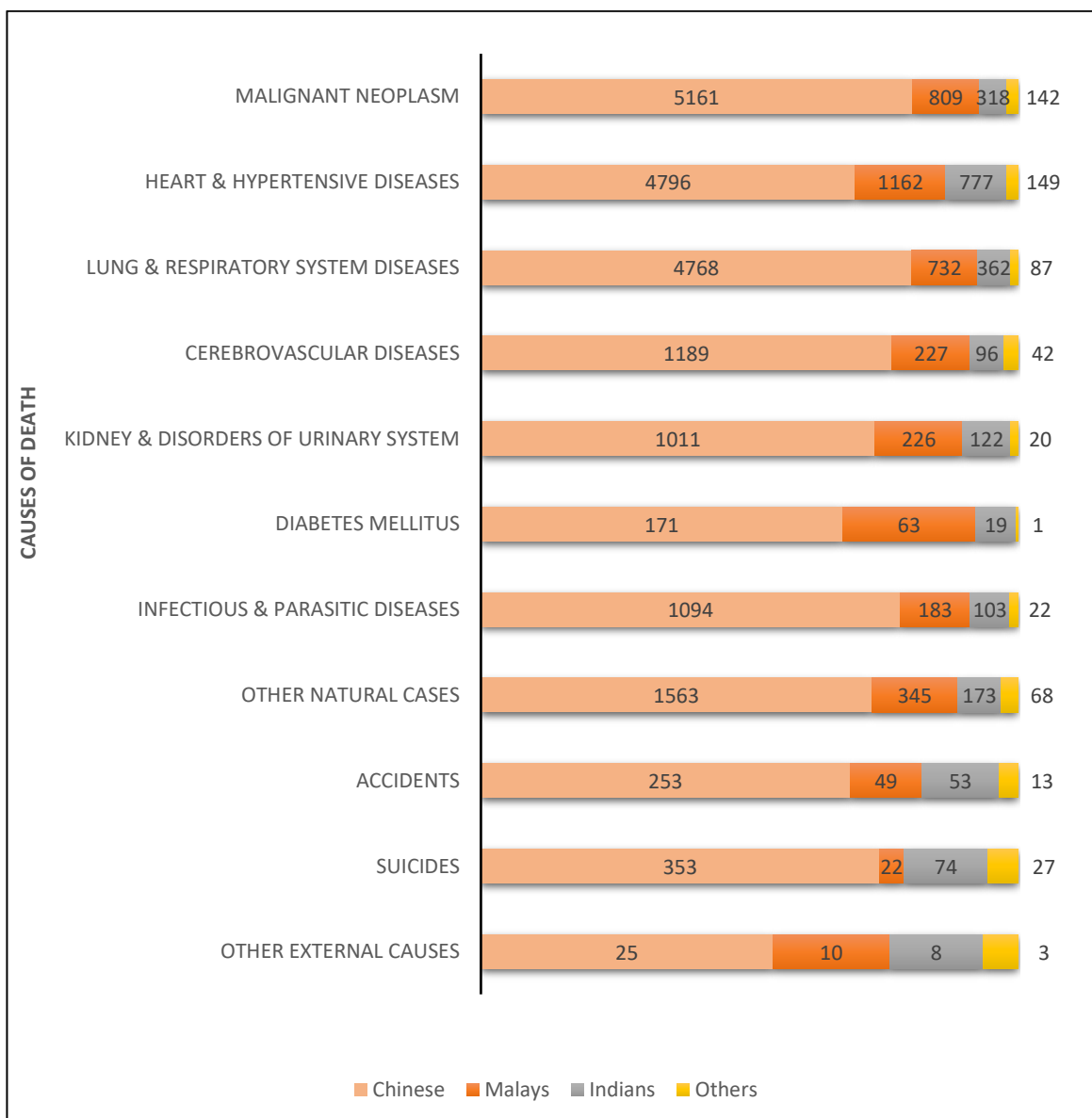

27 75.8% of deaths registered in 2022 were Chinese while Malays, Indians and other ethnic groups made up of 14.2%, 7.8% and 2.1% of death cases respectively (Chart 13).

Deaths

28 Table V shows that there were differences in the MA among different ethnic groups. The MA for Chinese was 80.4 years compared with 72.3 years for Malays, 71.9 years for Indians and 68.2 years for other ethnic groups. The gap in MA between Chinese and non-Chinese ethnic groups existed in most major causes of death.

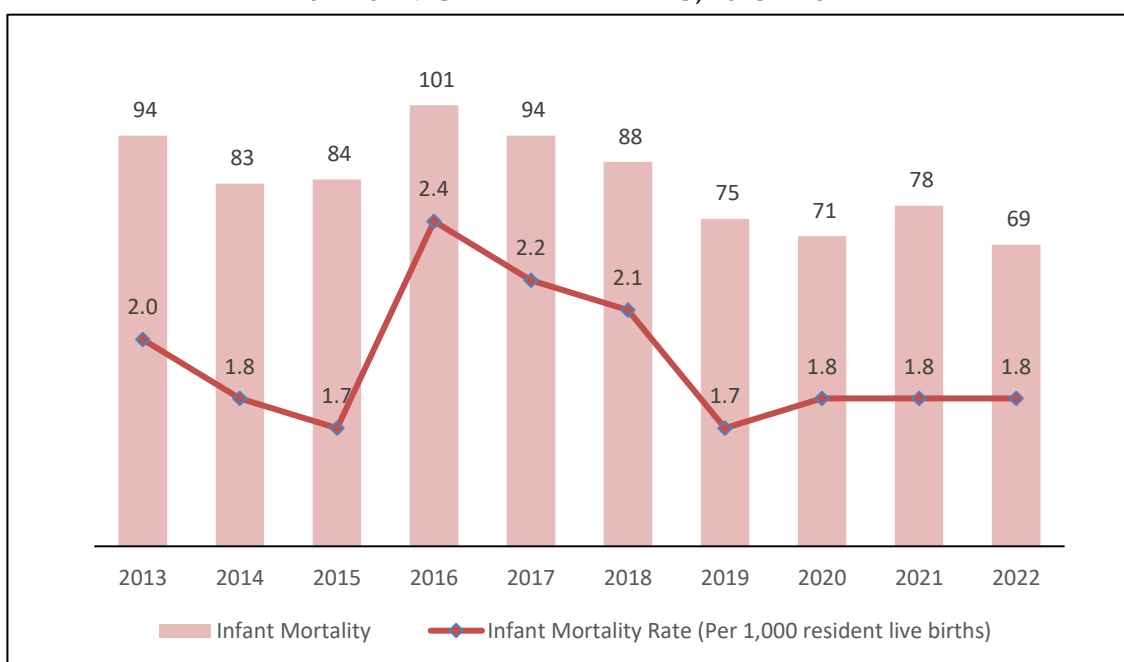

Deaths

Infant Mortality

29 Of the 69 infant deaths registered in 2022, 37 were males and 32 were females. The main causes of infant death were Perinatal Originated Conditions (44.9%) and Congenital Anomalies (21.7%). The infant mortality rate in 2022 was 1.8 per 1,000 resident live births (Chart 14).

Neonatal Mortality

30 The number fell slightly from 52 in 2013 to 41 in 2022. The neonatal mortality rate in 2022 remained the same as 2013 at 1.1 per 1,000 resident live births.

Perinatal Mortality

31 Including stillbirths⁴, there were 140 perinatal deaths registered in 2022. The perinatal mortality rate was 3.9 per 1,000 live births and stillbirths.

Maternal Mortality

32 In 2022, there was 1 case of maternal death registered.

Stillbirths

33 In 2022, there were 110 registered stillbirths⁵. Chart 15 shows that the crude stillbirth rates varied between 1.9 to 3.1 per 1,000 live births and stillbirths for the last 10 years.

34 Stillbirths registered in 2022 comprised of 54 males, 53 females and 3 cases with an unknown sex. Among the registered stillbirths, those occurring between 22 to 27 weeks of gestation period constituted 36.4% of the total stillbirth cases.

ANNEXURE

PROCEDURES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF LIVE BIRTHS, DEATHS AND STILLBIRTH⁶

LIVE BIRTHS

All births in Singapore must be registered within 42 days from the date of birth. Effective from 29 May 2022, all parents of newborns are required to register their child's birth online via LifeSG.

2 A fee of S\$18.00 is payable for the birth registration and issuance of a digital birth certificate.

DEATHS

3 Effective from 29 May 2022, a death in Singapore will be automatically registered once a doctor certifies the death online. After the doctor has certified the death online, the next-of-kin can download the digital death certificate at My Legacy website. There is no fee for death registration and issuance of a digital death certificate.

STILLBIRTHS

4 Effective from 29 May 2022, a stillbirth in Singapore will be automatically registered once a doctor certifies the stillbirth online. After the doctor has certified the stillbirth online, parents can download the digital stillbirth certificate at My Legacy website. There is no fee for stillbirth registration and issuance of a digital stillbirth certificate.

⁶ Prior to 29 May 2022, all live births, deaths and stillbirths are registered under the Registration of Births and Deaths Act enacted in 1937.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1 *Resident population* refers to Singapore citizens and permanent residents.
- 2 *Annual population growth rate* refers to the annual population increase per thousand population, and is based on Singapore residents only. For 2003, the annual population growth rate is computed based on 2003 unrevised population estimates which include residents who were overseas for a continuous period of 12 months or longer as at the reference period.
- 3 *Sex ratio* refers to the number of males per thousand females and is based on Singapore residents only.
- 4 *Natural increase* refers to the excess of births over deaths.
- 5 *Crude rate of natural increase* refers to the natural increase per thousand population. From 1980 onwards, this rate is based on Singapore residents only.
- 6 A *live birth* refers to a child, irrespective of the duration of gestation, which after the complete expulsion or extraction from the mother, breathes or shows any other signs of life. From 1953 onwards, the figures are based on date of occurrence. Prior to 1953, they are based on date of registration.
- 7 *Crude birth rate* refers to the number of live births per thousand population. From 1980 onwards, this rate is based on Singapore residents only.
- 8 *Birth order* refers to the numerical order of a child in relation to all previous live births of the mother. For births registered from 29 May 2022 onwards, birth order breakdowns are based solely on declared information.
- 9 Statistical breakdown by *educational qualification* and *occupation* of parents are based solely on declared information.
- 10 *Period of gestation* refers to the number of weeks a baby remained in the mother's womb before birth.
- 11 A *premature birth* refers to a birth with less than 37 weeks of gestation.
- 12 A *death* refers to the permanent disappearance of all signs of life of a living person at any time. Death figures referred to the number of deaths registered during the year.
- 13 *Crude death rate* refers to the number of deaths per thousand population. From 1980 onwards, this rate is based on Singapore residents only.

- 14 *Infant mortality* refers to death of persons under one year of age.
- 15 *Crude infant mortality rate* refers to the number of infant deaths per thousand live births. From 1980 onwards, this rate is based on resident live births only.
- 16 *Neonatal mortality* refers to death of persons under 28 days of age.
- 17 *Crude neonatal mortality rate* refers to the number of neonatal deaths per thousand live births. From 1990 onwards, this rate is based on resident live births only.
- 18 *Perinatal mortality* refers to stillbirth and death of persons under seven days of age.
- 19 *Crude perinatal mortality rate* refers to the number of perinatal deaths per thousand live births and stillbirths.
- 20 *Maternal mortality* refers to deaths of mothers owing to deliveries and complications arising from pregnancy, childbirth and puerperium.
- 21 *Crude maternal mortality rate* refers to the number of maternal deaths per hundred thousand live births.
- 22 A *stillbirth* refers to a child that issues from the child's mother after the 22 weeks⁷ of pregnancy and does not show any sign of life at any time after being completely expelled or extracted from the mother. Stillbirth figures referred to the number of stillbirths registered during the year.
- 23 *Crude stillbirth rate* refers to the number of stillbirths per thousand live births and stillbirths.
- 24 *Resident live births* refer to those with at least one parent who is Singapore citizen or permanent resident.
- 25 An *abandoned child* refers to a child whose local birth registered without the information of both parents.

⁷Before 29 May 2022, a stillbirth refers to a child that issues from the child's mother after the 28 weeks of pregnancy and does not show any sign of life at any time after being completely expelled or extracted from the mother.
